



Energy Australia Signs Wireless Broadband Deal

2 March 2010 --- Wireless Broadband Australia (WBA) – a Seven Network Limited Company formerly called Unwired Group – today announced an agreement with Energy Australia that will see some of WBA’s 2.3 GHz spectrum put to use for smart grid applications.

Under the agreement, Energy Australia will acquire 7 MHz of WBA’s 2.3 GHz spectrum in Sydney, Newcastle and the Central Coast for \$10 million.

The 7 MHz leaves WBA with 91 MHz, which is in line with its holdings in other markets and sufficient for the future needs of vividwireless.

This transaction follows an agreement reached for spectrum access with SPAusnet.
